What is the CEQA Hub?

CEQA Hub is a CEQA-specific intelligence hub from CEB built for California land use and environmental law attorneys. It brings together CEQA case law, strategic filing summaries, focused news and trend reporting, practical guidance and trusted secondary sources in one continuously updated environment designed specifically for CEQA practice.

What makes CEQA Hub different?

Unlike traditional research platforms that help attorneys find documents, CEQA Hub is built to help attorneys interpret CEQA changes and determine how those changes affect clients' projects across California.

What are the key features of CEQA Hub?

CEQA Hub includes five core capabilities:

- **Case Feed with Editorial Holdings**—CEQA appellate decisions enhanced with editorial holdings and CEQA-specific facets organizing cases by issue, exemption, project type, and procedural posture.
 - **Trusted Secondary Sources Integrated into Workflow**—A curated, searchable library of practitioner-trusted secondary sources, including Solano Press titles, integrated directly into the CEQA research workflow.
 - **California in Development Filing Summaries**—Exclusive editorial summaries highlighting strategically important CEQAnet filings that provide insight into emerging approaches, market trends, and evolving strategies.
 - **News and Market Trend Reporting**—Focused CEQA news and quarterly trend reporting distilling legislative changes, reform efforts, and evolving agency and judicial interpretation.
 - **Practical Guidance**—Task-oriented guidance designed for CEQA practice, including workflows addressing complex regulatory environments such as the California Coastal Commission.

What is CA in Development?

The intent of CA in Development is to help land use attorneys cut through the noise of the hundreds of filings that happen each day to identify the subset of documents that provide insights on market trends, interesting tactics, unusual mitigation measures, or shifts in agency policy. CEB works with subject matter experts, including lawyers and city planners, to identify filings that may be of strategic interest. We review new filings every day and publish CA in Development summaries to CEQA Hub within seven days of the file appearing in the State Clearinghouse.

What are the main benefits of using CEQA Hub?

CEQA Hub helps attorneys:

- Determine which developments materially affect clients' projects.
- Assess the practical impact of new legislation, agency policy, and other developments faster.
- See emerging market and litigation trends.
- Strengthen defensibility against potential CEQA challenges.
- Advise clients with greater confidence.

How often is the CEQA Hub updated?

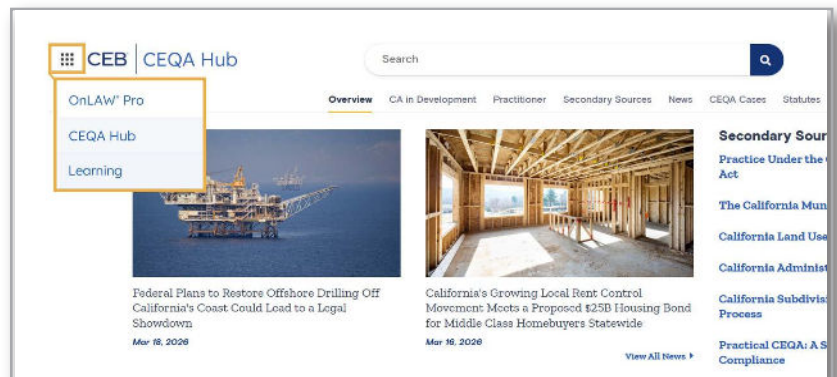
CEB's editorial team identifies new CEQA cases daily as part of its ongoing primary law review process. Published cases are added to CEQA Hub with full editorial markup within two days of the original case filing date. Unpublished decisions are published to CEQA Hub with full editorial markup within seven days of the original case filing date.
